RESEARCH LAB FOR CIVIL & ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING:

Cameron Room 257A (408 s.f.)

- Currently Unassigned
- NC DOT funded research – Civil & Environmental Engineering
- Time limited use of the room through 6/15/20
- Room as currently equipped is suitable for the research

MOSAIC and FADO RELOCATIONS:

TEMPORARY USE OF CATO 146 UNTIL START OF CONSTRUCTION:

Cato Room 146 (593 s.f.)
