### 5. Space Requests for Review and Action

The following requests were presented for review and action:

<u>Atkins 146 & suite 149</u> – Academic Affairs requested relocating the center for Graduate Life (CGL) from the  $2^{nd}$  floor of Cone to Atkins Library, suite 149 and meeting room 146.

Jay Raja explained the history of how CGL came to be in Cone. Though the building was primarily a student services building, it was the only space available at the time. The intention for some time has been to relocate CGL from Cone to a space that is better suited to CGL needs. The Atkins space can provide that space, however, Academic Affairs would like to eventually recover the Veteran Services space in Barnard (an academic building), and would like to see them relocate from Barnard into the space to be vacated by CGL in Cone, freeing up the space vacated in Barnard for Academic Affairs.

Space Management has met with Student Affairs regarding the possible relocation of Veteran Services to the CGL suite in Cone. Discussions are ongoing. While the CGL space in Cone is a good location for Veteran Services, Sujit Chemburkar submitted that one of the issues is the recent Student Affairs funding that went towards the renovation of the Veteran Services Lounge in Barnard.

Jay moved that the request be tabled until an agreement can be reached between Academic Affairs and Student Affairs for the Cone and Barnard spaces prior to SPACe consideration of the CGL move to Atkins. Clay Andrews seconded the motion. The motion passed.

<u>CAB 110</u> – Senior Engineering Projects was previously allocated use of portions of CAB and have asked to allocate an additional adjacent room, 110 as a computer room through the end of the Spring 2020 semester.

Rich Steele moved to approve the request, Jay Raja seconded – the motion was passed.

<u>Belk Gym 024</u> – Academic Affairs requested to relocate the Kinesiology Human Physiology Lab from Cameron 265 & 265A to allow for the planned Cameron  $2^{nd}$  floor renovation. Belk Gym 024 is currently allocated to Kinesiology as a Class Lab, the change in room category would be to a Research Lab.

Jay Raja moved to approve the room category change, Rich Steele seconded. The motion passed.

<u>Cameron 189</u> – Academic Affairs requested moving Geography and Earth Sciences McEniry 213 & 213A lab to Cameron 189 to allow for HVAC work to be done in McEniry. The room is currently allocated to Academic Affairs, office services. The change in room category would be to a Research Lab.

Jay Raja moved to approve the request, Clay Andrews seconded – the motion passed.

<u>Belk Gym 011/011A</u> – This space was previously allocated to Athletics for the Women's Swim Team. The start of the Women's Swim Team program is to be determined but will not be within the next few years. Student Affairs and Academic Affairs jointly request that room 011 be shared, scheduled use by Kinesiology/U Rec and Venture. Room 011 will be used as it is, no renovations are required. Three offices, 124, 125 & 126, currently allocated to Kinesiology will be used by Athletics to support a new lacrosse program. The request for room 011/011A and the three offices will be temporary, through 12/31/2022 at which time the three offices will revert back to Kinesiology.

Jay Raja moved to approve the request, Clay Andrews seconded - the motion passed

<u>Colvard 1<sup>st</sup> Floor</u> – Academic Affairs requests a new 88 seat (1,700 sf) Active Learning Classroom in the suite 1017/1018A Distance Education space. Distance Education will be moving into a new space previously allocated to them. A new location for the Communication Studies conference room 1018A will have to be identified prior to any work being done in room 1018A.

Clay Andrews moved to approve the request, Jay Raja seconded. The motion passed.

<u>CHHS 330/330A</u> – Room 330 (911sf) is currently a classroom assigned to AISLE. Academic Affairs is requesting that it be re-categorized as a class lab and subdivided into two simulation labs with a control room for Obstetrics and Pediatrics. Room 330A would be included in the renovated space

Clay Andrews moved to approve the request, Jay Raja seconded. The motion passed.

<u>Woodward 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor</u> – Academic Affairs requests that the existing Kinesiology Research Lab and associated lab service rooms in Cameron (238B, 93, 291 A&B, 293B, 271E, 263, 267, 293A, 265C, 267A and offices 295 & 293C) be relocated to Woodward. The spaces identified in Woodward are currently allocated to Biological Sciences (264, 275, 276, 276A), Biology has consented to this proposal.

Jay Raja moved to approve the request, Lee Gray seconded. The motion passed.









### **PROPOSED ROOM USE - CATEGORY CHANGE**




### **EXISTING SPACE** TO BE VACATED FOR HVAC **RENOVATION WORK IN MCENIRY**



- Athletics was formerly allocated Belk Gym 011 for the Women's Swim Team (2/7/2018) which now looks to be pushed several years out, TBD.
- Athletics is looking to start a LaCross program the most immediate need would be for 3 coaches offices (July '20) to be located in SAC, coaches from existing programs would be moved to Belk Gym offices
- Kinesiology, Venture and URec have an immediate need for scheduled use of a space in Belk Gym such as 011 (space would be used as-is) Kinesiology would agree to allow Athletics to use 3 offices (rooms 124, 125 & 126) that they were previously allocated, for coaches through 12/22, which would make 011 available for shared, scheduled use through 12/22.








## COLVARD – ACTIVE LEARNING CLASSROOM






### KINESIOLOGY – EXISTING LOCATION
